INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Alton is soliciting sealed bids from qualified contractors for the crushing and processing of stockpiled materials located at the Town's Rines Road Pit.

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked:

"ROCK & ASPHALT CRUSHING BID – DO NOT OPEN"

BID OPENING & AWARD

Sealed bids must be received by the Town of Alton no later than 2:00 PM on October 1st, 2026.

Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud immediately following the winter sand supply 2026-2027 Bid opening.

The Board of Selectmen will review bids and consider award at the October 13th, 2026 Board of Selectmen Meeting.

The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive informalities, negotiate minor irregularities, and award the contract in the best interest of the Town.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Town of Alton is requesting bids for the crushing and processing of a mixed stockpile of excavated materials located at the Rines Road Pit (Map19 Lot 52), Alton, New Hampshire.

The stockpile consists of approximately 5,000 cubic yards of mixed material, including:

- Excavated asphalt
- Concrete
- Brick
- Tailings
- Miscellaneous aggregate materials

The Town intends to crush and process as much material as funding allows.

The successful bidder shall provide a unit price per cubic yard processed.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT

Prior to submitting a bid, each bidder shall schedule a visit with the DPW to view the project site and familiarize themselves with existing conditions that may affect the cost, means, methods, or performance of the work.

Submission of a bid shall be considered evidence that the bidder has inspected the site and is satisfied with existing conditions.

MATERIAL PROCESSING REQUIREMENTS

The contractor shall process the stockpile into the following products:

Product No. 1

1½-Inch Crushed Gravel

Product No. 2

1½-Inch Crushed Stone

The Town reserves the right to direct the quantity of material produced for each product based upon operational needs.

Processed material shall be stockpiled on-site in locations designated by the DPW Director or Highway Foreman.

CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful contractor shall furnish all labor, supervision, equipment, tools, materials, fuel, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

This shall include, but not be limited to:

- Crusher(s)
- Screening equipment
- Loader(s)
- Excavator(s)
- Hydraulic hammer(s), if necessary
- Conveyors
- Mobilization and demobilization
- Fuel and lubricants
- Maintenance and repairs
- Labor and supervision

The crushing equipment utilized shall be capable of processing material containing rock up to 24 inches in diameter.

UNSUITABLE MATERIALS

The contractor shall be responsible for removing unsuitable materials encountered in the stockpile prior to crushing, including but not limited to:

- Wood
- Loam
- Organic material
- Brush
- Miscellaneous debris

Unsuitable material shall be sorted and separated from the processed product for disposal by the Town.

SCHEDULING

Following contract award, the Town shall issue a Notice to Proceed.

Upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed, the contractor may coordinate a mutually agreeable start date with the DPW Director.

Once work has commenced, the contractor shall continue operations in a continuous manner, weather permitting, until the project is complete.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Authorized crushing operations shall be limited to:

Monday through Friday
7:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Saturday operations may be permitted with prior approval from the DPW Director.

No Sunday or holiday operations shall be permitted unless specifically approved by the Town.

ESTIMATED QUANTITY

The stockpile is estimated at approximately: 5,000 Cubic Yards

This quantity is an estimate only and is intended solely for bid comparison purposes.

The Town does not guarantee any minimum quantity.

The quantity processed shall be subject to available funding and field conditions.

MEASUREMENT & PAYMENT

Payment shall be based on the actual cubic yards of material processed and accepted by the Town.

The contractor shall submit invoices identifying:

- Quantity processed
- Unit price
- Date(s) of work performed

Payment terms shall be Net 30 Days upon receipt and approval of invoice.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor agrees to furnish and maintain during the period of the awarded contract, at its own cost, policies of insurance to the Town of Alton as follows:

Prior to the start of any work, the Town must be furnished with a current Certificate of Insurance confirming the following minimum coverages. Certificates shall be filed with the Town Finance Office.

Minimum Insurance Coverage Requirements

- General Liability: \$1,000,000
- Property Damage: \$500,000
- Personal Injury: \$500,000
- Automobile Liability: \$250,000
- Workers' Compensation: \$250,000

The Town reserves the right to require additional coverage if deemed necessary.

TERM & TERMINATION

This is a one-time contract.

The Town reserves the right to:

- Reject any and all bids
- Waive informalities
- Suspend work for safety concerns
- Cancel the contract if the contractor fails to perform in accordance with the contract requirements
